Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you
	State law and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. PrimeTrust Financial Federal Credit Union has no affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. PrimeTrust Financial Federal Credit Union does not share with our nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies and financial service providers.
